

eSafety Week / Safer Internet Day reflections

What have been the main messages of the week?

Behave safely and responsibly
What to do if something inappropriate comes up on the screen
Be aware of pop-ups, sharing information
Do not open suspicious emails and attachments
Don't post personal info online
Stop and think before posting photos
Check friend requests in games with a trusted adult
Don't take pictures with details of where you live, car reg, school uniform etc
Click on privacy settings
Report people who request personal information
The internet is a good education tool
If you see something that makes you uncomfortable then tell a trusted adult and report
Ask your parents/carers before posting
Don't be worried about the internet
Don't believe everything you see on the internet
Have fun
Don't communicate with strangers
If a photo embarrasses you, don't post it

What online behaviour will you change because of your learning this week?

Check app terms and conditions
Check whether profile is 'Public' by default
Make sure everything is on the maximum privacy settings
Tell a trusted adult if something inappropriate appears
Only use trusted websites
Always ask someone if it is ok to send
Be more aware when gaming online
Don't accept random friend requests
Don't use a real name for an avatar/username in a game
Don't take a selfie for a profile of a game
Always tell a parent or teacher if you are worried about anything
Get permission before going on websites
Don't go online unless an adult is with me
Report 'rude' user names
Look at age limits on games
Make sure that I know the person I am communicating with
