- They will be assessed in dictation form on Friday





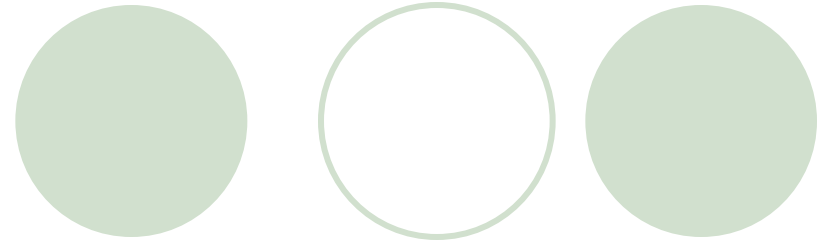
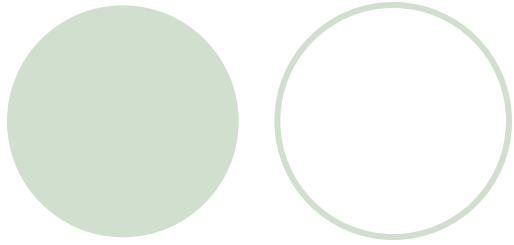
# Behaviour and Responsibilities

- Buddy role

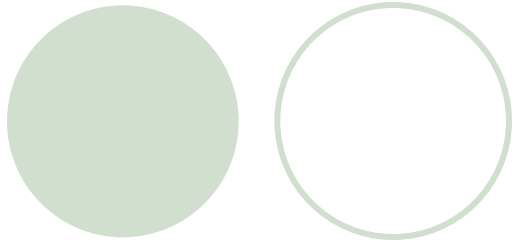
