- Duxford?

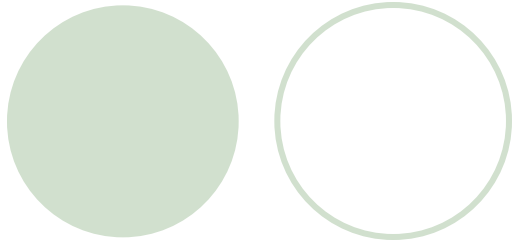
Mobile Phones



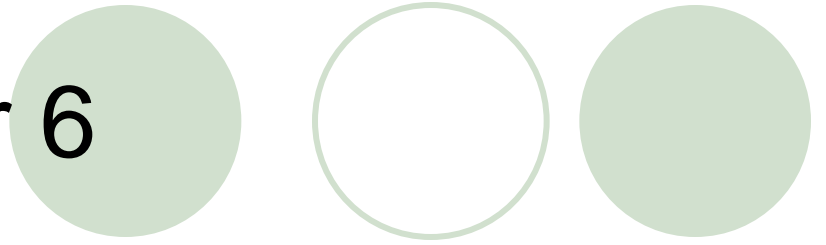
- If necessary, need to write a letter to Ms Clifford requesting permission.
