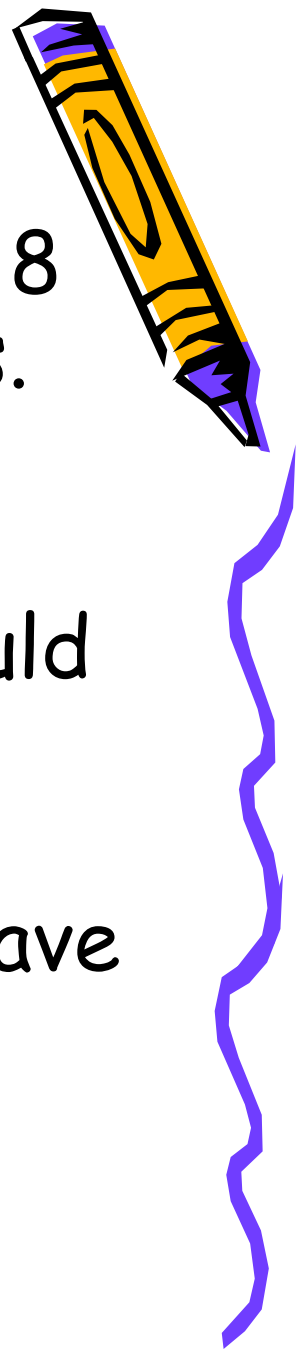
Homework
