# Homework

- o Children to hand planners in on a Monday
- o Library day is Monday



## o Reading

Planners should be filled in by your child three times a week. Please continue to read with your child. They may be able to read it but with good questioning, you will ensure they have understood it too. **Handwriting pen** please to be used in planners.

- o Really important to know times tables and corresponding division facts
- o Any messages can go in planner – remind children to give to me please
- o Wallet for homework sheets
- o Homework club – Monday & Tuesday Lunch time

# Spellings

- o 8 spellings per week chosen by the children
- o Children to write spellings in a sentence in spelling book which goes home (on a Monday back on Friday)
- o To be assessed in dictation form on Friday



# SATs

- o Week Beginning: 13.05.19 May
- o Spelling and Grammar
- o Reading Paper
- o No mental maths test – arithmetic + 2 non calculator papers
- o Expectations are higher
- o They are important but we aim **not** to make them stressful for the children
- o A few Practice papers throughout the year
- o Please do not look at past papers online as this may give a false result!
- o Breakfast Club – we will be asking for volunteers closer to the time
