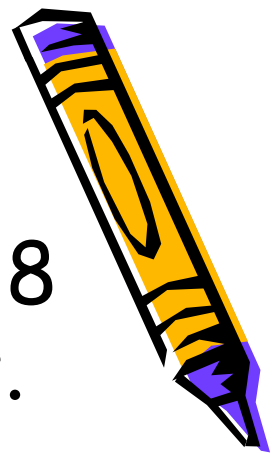
# Homework

**Resilience – to learn from our mistakes and always try our best, even when we find things difficult.**

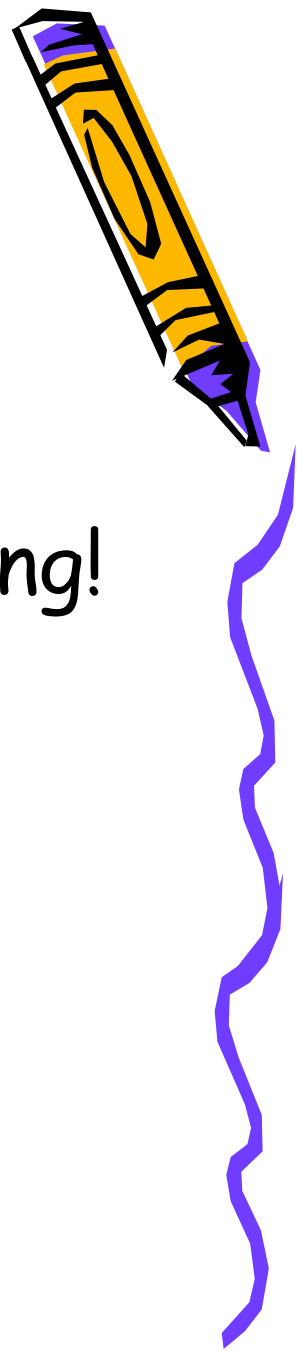
# Uniform
