





# Daily Routines






# After school meetings



## Trips and Events

- Music is on Tuesday




# Homework

- Please also practise times tables as often as possible.




# Spelling Homework


- The children need to use their 8 words in 8 different sentences.

# Planners





- At least 3 entries a week.




# Uniform
