- Children to write each into a sentence. The spelling book will go home on a Monday to be handed in on Friday.
- To be assessed in dictation form on Friday

- Spelling and Grammar
- Reading Paper
- No mental maths test 1 x arithmetic + 2 x reasoning papers
- Expectations are high
