General rules and Routines

Homework

- Spellings are given on a Monday and are due on a Friday.
- Planners will be collected on Thursday.
- Learning logs and SlumDog will be assigned alternating Thursdays and will be due in the following Thursday (One week to complete).
- Library books come back on Monday.
- Children can ask any member of staff for help with homework (homework club is Monday and Tuesday).
- I will help children with incomplete homework during golden time.

Spelling

- Children need to use 8 words in different sentences
- These words will be sent home every Monday.
- All the words should be spelt correctly and the usual high standards of presentation should be maintained.
- Feel free to help your children by pointing out sentences with errors.
- I am happy to help with the checking and we will be looking at these on a Friday.

Planners

- At least 3 entries a week.
- Reflective comments — front pages of planners will help with questions to answer.
- Reluctant writers can be helped with the writing as long as they discuss the reading with an adult.

Behaviour

- As in the rest of the school we expect all children to follow the behaviour code.
- We aim to create a positive learning environment where certificates and house points may be given.
- We also have table points and individual recognition of positive presence in the classroom.
- In addition golden time is given weekly to reward positive behaviour.
