Maths

Formal written methods of multiplication and division Fractions (equivalence, comparing and ordering, adding and subtracting) Problem solving with all four operations Multiplying fractions by whole numbers and problem solving Converting units of measure Percentages and problem solving

English

We will continue to focus on our Grammar skills and using our best presentation at all times. We will be working as a school on JOURNEY by Aaron Becker where we will be working on developing spoken language, text engagement and writing stamina.

We will learn about the different forces that act on objects, such as friction, gravity, pushing and pulling forces, buoyancy etc.

We will also begin looking at living things and their habitats. We will learn about the relationships between animals and their environment and the importance of balance in ecosystems.

Geography

We will be looking at mountain during our geography lessons. We will learn how they are formed, where they appear and how they affect the lives of the people around them

Art and DT

In Art we will be learning about sculpture. We will focus on the work of sculptors such as Barbara Hepworth and Anish Kapoor. In DT we will be making our own electric cars and Maximizing their design for drag racing speed.

Computing

In Computing, we will be looking at databases. We will be learning about how these tools are used to manage information. We will also be making music videos for GroveFest using video editing software and creating our own digital games.

French

In French, we will be learning about food and places in our local town.

Music

We will be studying the dramatic piece 'A Night on the Bare Mountain' by Modest Mussorgsky, looking at how the musical elements are used to create excitement. We will create our own version of the piece using a variety of pitched and un-pitched percussion, recognising the difference between drone and melody.

The musical elements focus for our compositions will be pitch, tempo, and dynamics.
