# Things to remember.

# Medical

# Home Learning

- New spelling pattern words are given out on FRIDAY and are due back in school on the following THURSDAY. This allows a full week including a weekend to practice, investigate and explore the current spelling patterns.
- Children will write 8 sentences using the spelling words which will also show their understanding of definition and to practice expanding sentence structure skills.
- All the words should be spelt correctly and the usual high standards of presentation should be maintained. Please use a suitable blue pen.
- Feel free to help your children create engaging sentences and alert them to any errors



# Home Learning

- Reading planners return! Children should read every day and it is the expectation that a minimum of three comments are made which reflect the reading focus of the week – either by parent or pupil.
- Books are to be brought into school every day and the reading planner will be viewed every Thursday. Your child will not bring their reading planner home on a Thursday as this gives your teacher time to acknowledge the reading comments.
- Please only use suitable pens in planners.
- The planners will be returned to your child on Friday.

# Home Learning

- Children will be able to visit the library in small groups throughout the week.
- Encourage regular trips to the local library – please join. It's a great resource and skill and definitely an alternative to Google and Wikipedia!
- Encourage your children to access the TTRockstars app which will promote fluency and fast recall.
- Encourage your child to read all the clocks at home, both analogue and digital. Calculate duration of time that tasks may take.
- From time to time, we may politely ask for your support in providing some resources to enhance the children's learning.
