- OChildren should be practising their spellings throughout the week not just during the sentences

### SATs

- O Reading Paper Tuesday
- O Arithmetic and reasoning 1 Wednesday
- O Reasoning 2 Thursday

### SATs

- O They are important but we aim **not** to make them stressful for the children
- O Practice papers throughout the year including two mock SATs weeks
- O Please do not look at past papers online as this may give a false result in class!
- Breakfast Club during SATs week we will be asking for volunteers closer to the time
