Reading

There will be a focus each week which will be written into the planner on a Friday.

Please continue to read with your child. They may be able to read it but with good questioning, you will ensure they have understood it too.

Spellings

- 0 8 spellings per week chosen by the children
- O Usually based on a weekly spelling pattern
- To be assessed on a Friday
- O Children should be practising their spellings throughout the week not just during the sentences
