- O Role models



Reading and times tables

They may be able to read it but with good questioning, you will ensure they have understood it too. **Handwriting pen** to be used in planners. There will be a focus each week which will be written into the planner on a Friday.


Year 6 should know all multiplication facts (up to 12 x 12) and corresponding division facts. Can use TT Rockstars or Hit the Button.



- 0 8 spellings per week chosen by the children which follow a particular spelling pattern
- O Children to write each spelling in a sentence in spelling book which goes home on Friday
- O In Year 6 children should aim for interesting and complex sentences
- O To be assessed in dictation form on Friday
- O Children should be practising their spellings throughout the week not just while writing the sentences

SATs

- Week Beginning: 8th May 2023
- O Grammar, punctuation and spelling
- Reading Paper
- Maths arithmetic + 2 reasoning papers
- Expectations are high
- O They are important but we aim not to make them too stressful for the children
- O A few practice papers throughout the year
- Please ensure that past papers are not used out of school as this will give a false result!
- O Breakfast Club we will be asking for volunteers closer to the time
