We borrowed polling equipment from the local authority so the children could experience how adults vote at a polling station.



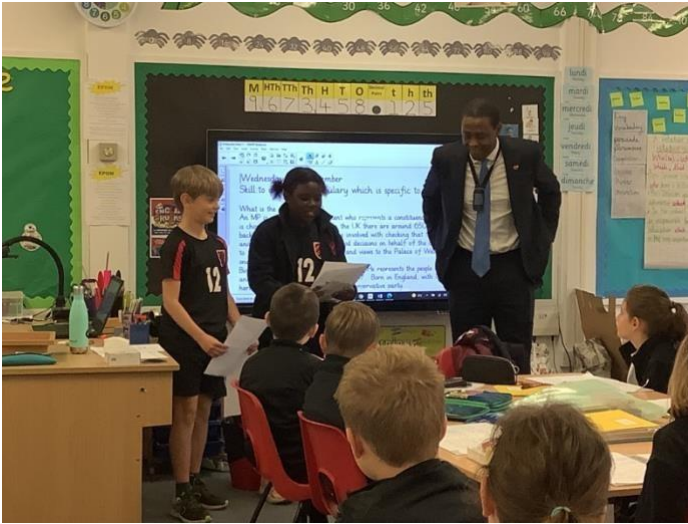
Each child had a ballot slip for all the candidates from their class.
