## **Uniform**

- PE kit is worn on the days they have it (Tuesday and Thursday). Please note all jewellery should be removed, or micropore tape may be used to cover studs. Trainers only on PE days please.

#### Medical

- Please ensure if your child wears glasses, they have them in school daily and that we know about them.
- Inform me/the office of any new medical conditions, changes or updates. This is vital particularly for SWIMMING!
