


- O I have been a teacher for over 30 years.

Uniform

- O Planner (coming soon!) and reading book

Homework

- O Evidence of reading 5 times a week in planner
- O Planner to be signed each week
- O Children to hand planners in on a Thursday to be signed by the teacher/ TA
- O Spelling homework to be completed in beige spelling books and handed in on Thursdays
- O Maths homework to be set on Mathletics due in on Thursdays
- O Times table practice

Year 6 should know all multiplication facts (up to 12 x 12) and corresponding division facts. Use TT Rockstars or Hit the Button.

Reading

Please continue to read with your child. They may be able to read their book but with good questioning, you will ensure they have understood it too.

Handwriting pen to be used in planners.



- o 8 spellings per week chosen by the children which follow a particular spelling pattern
- O To be assessed in dictation form on Friday
- O Children should be practising their spellings throughout the week not just while completeing the homework activity
- List of Year 5 and 6 spelling words in planners for useful revision

SATs

- Week Beginning: 13th May 2024
- Monday Grammar and Punctuation 45 mins, spelling 20 questions
- Tuesday Reading 1 hour
- Wednesday Arithmetic 30 mins,
 Reasoning 40 mins
- Thursday Reasoning 40 mins
- Writing and Science is assessed by the teacher
- Grades will be WTS, EXS or GDS

SATS

- They are important but we aim **not** to make them too stressful for the children
- A few practice papers throughout the year and 2 Mock Sats weeks
- Please ensure that past papers are not used out of school
- Breakfast Club we will be asking for volunteers nearer the time
